
No newsletter last month as the meeting was so soon after the New Year. Business as usual this month!

Kaffe Facett's exhibition at the Fashion and Textile museum in Bermondsey is still ongoing. Entitled Kaffe Fassett: The power of Pattern - it explores Fassett's world with some of his own original artworks as well as other work inspired by him from some international quilters and makers My friend attended and says it is well worth a visit.

Hours: The museum is open Tuesdays – Saturdays, 11.00 – 18.00 with last entry 45 minutes before closing. It is closed on Sundays and Mondays but they have a special event on 16th and 9th March where you can visit for a late night opening and look at the exhibition with a glass of fizz. Advanced booking is recommended for entry and regular tickets cost £12.65 with some concessions.
