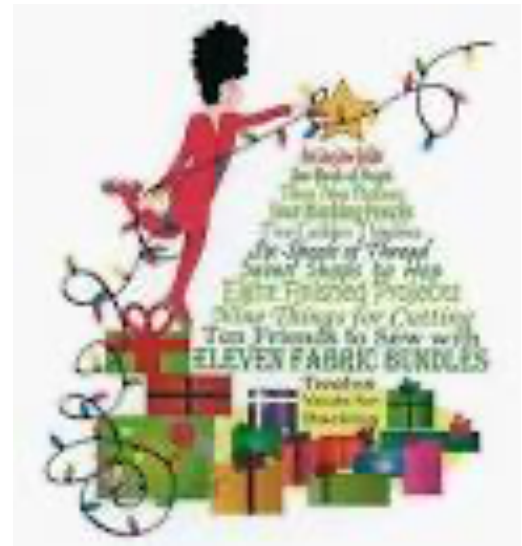
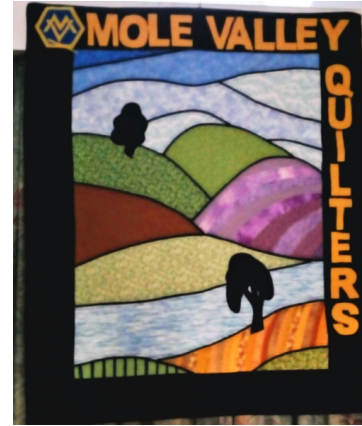
Xmas is nearly and for me it means some last minute rushing as my family are coming home on Wednesday from Australia for 3 weeks.

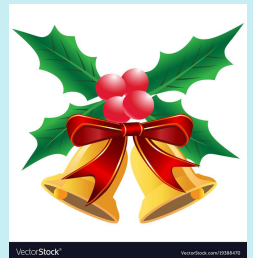
