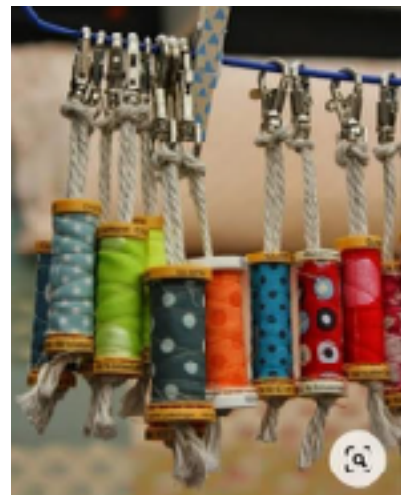
## December Meeting - Party Night!

- A bodkin/ large eyed needle for threading through the cord would also be useful !

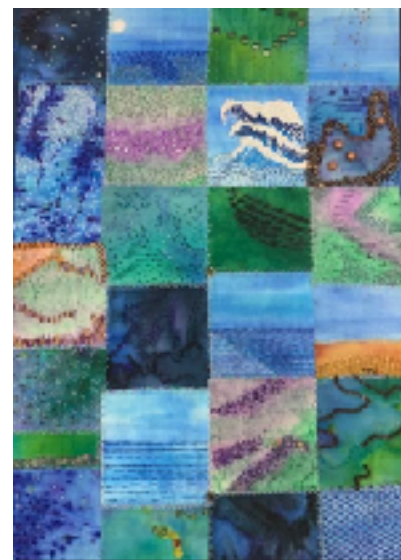
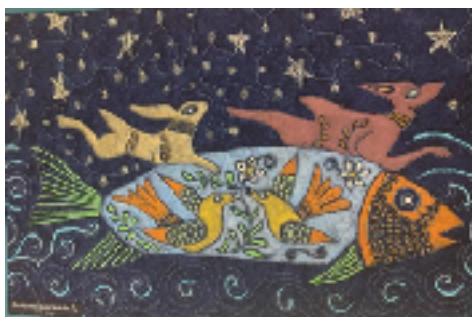
There will be festive refreshments and a raffle.
